

The Island's tea has found favour amongst a global palate, as the Island produces 28 different grades of tea from diverse climatic regions of the country, and for its distinct quality. While the hill country has earned regard as the tea producing region in the country, as much as 60 percent of the total production originates in the low-country regions of Sabaragamuwa and Ruhuna which range in elevation from sea level to 800m. The Island's low-grown tea has witnessed a high demand in the world market as no other country

is capable of producing this grade of tea. The colour, flavour, aroma and strength of the liquor all vary from region to region which in turn results in an industry that is able to cater to the tastes of different markets.

For these reasons Ceylon Tea has made its mark as a special commodity in the world market, fetching record prices. It must be said, Ceylon, the former name of Sri Lanka, has prevailed and remains synonymous with quality tea the world over.




Our Brew

Superior quality, high, medium and low grown teas of Sri Lanka are cultivated at our plantations that total 20,000 ha. Aside from gaining renown as the award winning producer of the finest quality tea of an eclectic range, Stassen can also account for some of the finest plantations in Asia. Lush expanses of our tea estates can be found in the Central, Uva, and Sabaragamuwa provinces – varied altitudes which yield tea of different flavours. Some of the prestigious tea estates under our stewardship include Kirkoswald, Pettiagalla,

It was as early as 1982 that we, Stassen Exports, gained recognition amongst industry giants, earning our place as the fifth largest exporter of quality tea from Sri Lanka. Six years later we earned distinction as the country's leading exporter, while in 1987, through Stassen Natural Foods, we established the world's first internationally certified organic tea garden, thereby becoming the first manufacturer of certified organic tea in the world. With an annual production of 200 tonnes, we are one of the largest organic tea producers in the world.





The Art of Tasting

Tea tasting can be described as an art. Essentially it is an art of association that involves five main steps. First, is the examining of dry leaves, followed by the brewing of leaves at the appropriate time and temperature, next, observing the tea and smelling the tea, and finally, tasting the tea.

The leaves' characteristics are a good indicator of the quality of the liquor to be brewed and one of the initial steps is to ensure that the tea being brewed is of the right kind. While the leaves should be consistent with one another, the size must be measured as it will influence the quality of tea. Furthermore, the aroma of dried leaves affords a preview of the liquor's taste. Following these initial steps of ascertaining the quality and freshness, the tea is brewed. The temperature

of the water may be varied with the type of tea, however, the ratio of tea to water remains constant. The colour of the tea is an indication of whether the tea has been brewed correctly. And it is the brewed tea leaves that the Tasters inhale to identify the smell of tea. Aromatic compounds vaporise fast, releasing the smell, and the tea taster must inhale deeply and repeatedly to correctly identify the scents.

To taste the tea, the Taster does not drink it, but rather slurps it to aerate the tea and allow more aromas to come in contact with the olfactory region. This way the tea is not only tasted but its aroma inhaled as well to help correctly determine the body and flavour of the liquor.





BLACK TEA

Black tea makes up the majority of tea sold in the world and is popular for its rich colour and taste. The traditional robust brew is produced when tea leaves are subjected to the complete range of processing stages of withering, rolling, oxidation, desiccation and grading.






Irish Breakfast

Irish Breakfast tea is a blend of several black teas. Because of its strength, it is commonly served with milk, but may also be enjoyed black or with sugar.







Darjeeling





Pineapple



KIRKOSWALD SINGLE GARDEN TEA

Named after founding partners Kirk and Oswald, the estate was one of the first plantations to substitute coffee with tea. Classified as Western High at an elevation of 1280m, the estate is found within the Dimbulla/Bogawantalawa region of the Nuwara Eliya District in the

Central Province. Kirkoswald holds pride of place as one of the most famous names in Ceylon Tea.

Located at the upper range of high grown elevations, the plantation is sheltered from harsh monsoon winds

and produces primarily black teas of bright liquors and infusions. The large well-defined leaves produce medium-strength tea that bears a distinct flowery aroma. Tea produced amidst the crisp and balmy dry season yields a bright flavoursome tea fit for a cup without milk and sugar. What's more, Kirkoswald has earned repute for gaining the highest prices for liquoring pekoes and flowery broken orange pekoes.

At present the Kirkoswald estate is in the process of producing Oolong Tea among other specialty teas such as Silver Tips and Golden Tips.

A testament of its superior quality and commitment to excellence, Kirkoswald has attained the ISO 9001:2008 and ISO 22,000:2005 certifications, and is HACCP certified in compliance with global standards.

IDULGASHINNA

Stassen Natural Foods (Pvt) Ltd is the pioneer producer of certified Organic Tea worldwide, and the tradition of certified organic cultivation continues today at the Idulgashinna Bio Tea Garden, which produces the best quality Organic Black Tea, Organic Green Tea, and Handmade Organic Designer Tea varieties. Classified as Uva High at an elevation of 1800m, the estate is found within Haputale in the Uva Province. The green and black teas harvested from the upper ranges possess a sharp and refreshing taste.







PETTIAGALLA

Classified as Uva Medium at an elevation of 800m, the estate is located in Balangoda of the Ratnapura District in the Sabaragamuwa Province. The estate is known to produce black tea marked with an exceptionally fruity flavour that has drawn comparison with jam. The tea makes a complementary brew with cakes and scones, and is best taken plain or with a slice of lemon. Pettiagalla tea has won many awards internationally.








GOWERAKELLE

The estate at an elevation of 1,280m is classified as Uva High in Demodara of the Badulla District in the Uva Province. Gowerakelle estate is home to a state-of-the-art green tea processing factory that produces crystal-clear liquor. The brew bears a hue that can vary from orange-green to pale pink and during the monsoon season infuses a lingering rush of flavour.

WELL-BEING

Among these initiatives are the provision of nutrition and worm treatment for children from birth up to three years of age. In addition to monitoring their activities, in the event that a child needs special medical attention (disability in walking, speech or hearing), Stassen provides for the cost of treatment at the hospital.

The members of the community can also take advantage of medical programmes that include free consultations and medication at all clinics. Medical clinics and health education seminars that impart valuable information on diseases such as HIV/AIDS and vaccination are important aspects of the programme. In addition, the programme facilitates the welfare of household pets through preventive measures to curb diseases such as rabies.

EDUCATION

Currently six primary schools have been established at different divisions of the estate under the Group's initiatives. Each caters to an average of 25 children. Primary school toys and study materials are provided to the children as and when they are enrolled in school. In addition, scholarships are also provided for Year 5 and Advanced Level students that cover the expenses for their study materials.

Individuals over the age of 16 years can benefit from enrolling in vocational training programmes in order to find suitable career paths and opportunities.





RECREATIONAL

Hosting training sessions and providing necessary facilities for extracurricular activities and talent development programmes contribute towards a more complete upbringing and development of the youth. These activities encompass Bharata and Kandyan dance classes, and sports such as volleyball and netball.

A playground has also been provided at the Idulgashinna estate premises for their benefit.

A village integration programme is currently underway to encourage interaction and bridge difference amongst diverse communities. This objective is facilitated by community involvement in group activities, multi-cultural functions and language classes initiated by the programme.




